### Educational cum Recreational Tour by The Textile Association (India) – Delhi

The Textile Association (India) – Delhi is organizing an Educational cum Recreational Tour from Delhi to Jim Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand for its Members along with their spouse and children during 25th March, 2021 to 27th March, 2021.

The Itinerary of the tour would be as follow:

- 25th March, 2021: Departure to Jim Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand via Volvo Bus in the Morning at 7 AM from Rajendra Place, New Delhi reaching Jim Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand in the afternoon
- 2 Night stay in Aahana Resort & Spa on twin sharing basis
- Sight-seeing at Jim Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand
- 27th March, 2021: Arrival Back at Delhi in the Evening
